OSHA 10 Hour Construction: This course is intended to provide an entry level construction worker's general awareness on recognizing and preventing hazards on a construction site. Topic areas include: Safety & Training Provisions; Occupational Health & Environmental Controls; Personal Protective Equipment & Life Saving Equipment; Fire Protection; Electrical; Confined Space Entry; Hand & Power Tools; Scaffolding; Floor & Wall Openings; Stairway & Ladders; Material Handling; and Excavation & Trenching. This day and a half course is set to take place on February 4, 2016 from 8:00am to 4:30pm and February 5, 2016 from 8:00am to 12:00pm at the NCCC.

Trenching/Excavation: This course will focus on OSHA Standards and on the safety aspects of excavation and trenching. Students are introduced to practical soil mechanics and its relationship to the stability of protected and unprotected slopes and walls of excavations and trenches. Various types of protective systems and techniques will also be discussed. Thursday, February 11, 2016 8:00am to 4:30pm at the NCCC.
