Lock Out/Tag Out : This course meets the requirements outlined in OSHA 29 CFR 1910.147 for training of employees in the control of energizing, starting, or stored energy in machinery or equipment which could cause injury to employees. **NNNOC Tuesday, April 5, 8am-12pm**

Electrical Safety: Focuses on workplace electrical safety and the application of industry accepted standards to effectively manage arc flash and electrical shock hazards. The training also provides guidance on applying “Safe Work Practices” to your daily electrical maintenance tasks. This training will help bring workers up to speed on the latest version of NFPA70E and OSHA Subpart S. **NCCOC, Tuesday April 12, 8am-4:30pm.**
